The Last 5 Months:

Confirmation: I have had the chance to observe as well as teach confirmation classes at Bethany. I have also been able to teach weekly in a one on one basis with a confirmation who has a time conflict with the time the confirmation class meets. This has been a wonderful experience for me to learn and to teach, and I am excited to finish out the rest of this year with the kids!

Bible Studies: I have had the privilege of participating and leading Bible Studies in many different contexts including nursing homes, Men's Bible Study at Bethany, the Monday Quilting Group, text studies, and circles. I have enjoyed delving into God's Word with all of these different groups of people, and learning from their perspectives as well as sharing my own.

Preaching: I have had numerous opportunities to preach while here, at Bethany and Lost Island, as well as at the various nursing homes in the area, and once at the Methodist Church in Ruthven. I appreciate the feedback I have gotten from all of you in regards to my preaching and look forward to our continued conversation around the Gospel.

Internship Committee Meetings: I have valued the feedback I have received from those on my internship committee, as well as feedback from the congregation which has been delivered to me through those on the committee. The internship committee meetings have been productive and I am thrilled to see how these congregations have committed to their roles as a teaching parish.

Worship Board: I have attended the worship board meetings and enjoyed being a part of the planning process of the services each week. I have also appreciated that the board has been gracious enough to humor some of my suggestions.

Youth Groups: Over the course of the last 5 months I have had opportunities to participate in each of the three youth groups. It has been great to be a part of faith coming alive in the lives of these young people.

Worship Leadership: I have been involved in leading worship almost every Sunday since my arrival at either or both churches.

Council: It has been an educational experience for me to be a part of the council meetings each month and to see first hand how the members of these congregations come together to take responsibility for the church and the missions of the church.

Counseling: I have had the opportunity to do some counseling for individual members of the church, within the realm of my qualifications.

Internship Cluster: I, along with some of my classmates have the responsibility of planning the internship cluster meeting for the spring of this year for interns and supervisors in Iowa.

Joint Potluck Picnic/Family Fun Day: I am working on planning an event which will be hosted by both Lost Island and Bethany, at Centennial Park in Ruthven. This event will be put on by volunteers from each congregation and will include a potluck and fun for all ages. I am currently looking for volunteers so if you are interested please let me know!

Lifest: In July I will be taking a group of youth to a Christian music festival in Oshkosh Wi, called Lifest.

Prison After Care Team: Later this spring I will be working on putting together a Prison After Care team in Palo Alto County, involving area churches whose purpose is to help people who are released from prison into this area become reintegrated into society, helping them to find housing, work, etc. to help them remove themselves from any toxic environments they were previously in that led to their arrest.
